Did you know... As a creative worker, you would be entering a profession in which Britain excels? There are more than ¼ million businesses in the creative industries and they're worth £92 billion, growing twice as fast as the rest of the economy. The sector employs 2 million people and accounts for 1 in 11 jobs in the UK. Research shows that the creative industries are on average at low or no risk of automation compared to other industries. The skills used in innovation are not easily replaceable by a machine and, in fact, computers complement most creative processes, making creative skills more productive. Think about how computers have enhanced creative work in fashion design, photography, music and film production for example. Working in the creative sector is all about following your passion for originality – using your imagination to develop new ideas and techniques and to challenge the norm.

There are now also a varied number of apprenticeships available in the Creative sector, routes to becoming a Bespoke Tailor and Cutter, an Advertising and Media Executive, a Fashion Studio Assistant, a Product Design and Development Engineer, a Furniture Design Technician, an Event Assistant, a Broadcast Operator, a TV or Radio Producer again, the list goes on and on!
