

Keyword	Definition
Abstract	an outcome that deliberately does not appear in the likeness of the original
Accurate	correct in all detail
Acrylic Paint	synthetic emulsion- very quick drying
Aesthetics	concerned with the visual elements of beauty of something/ visual attractiveness
Annotations	notes made around drawings or images that you have collected
Applique	decorate a piece of fabric with other pieces of fabric sewn or stuck onto the surface.
Art Gallery	public building of art displays
Artisan	worker in a skilled trade, especially involving handmade items.
Batch production	a specific number/amount of goods produced at one time.
Brief	a set of instructions
Ceramics	work in clay
Chalk pastel	soft colour stick used for blending colour in a soft visual effect.
Charcoal	like pastels but more brittle, made from burnt wood and only black
Collage	making work using multiple torn textures or materials
Colour wheel	primary, secondary, and tertiary colours laid out in their relationship with each other+C53
Complementary colours	those opposite each other- they show each other off to their best.

Composition	how things are arranged in a picture
Critical studies	history of art and artists
Cross hatch	form of shading using short lines which cross each other at an angle
Develop	to grow or advance an idea
Dimensions	the measurements of a product which include, depth, width, height
Drawing	making marks to produce a careful likeness
Durability	withstand wear, pressure, or damage
Efficient	maximum productivity with minimum waste/effort
Embellishment	decorative detail or feature added to make something more attractive
Embroidery	decorative stitches
Ergonomics	the science of designing for ultimate comfort in use
Evaluation	a written or verbal assessment of the thought process behind a piece of work
Fabric	cloth produced by weaving or knitting textile fibres
Felt	hand or machine-made bonded fabric (usually wool)
Figurative	art showing something from the visible world
Form	solid nature of an object
Gouache	opaque watercolours
Hazard	something that can cause harm
Hem	the edge of a piece of fabric folded over to the inside and sewn to prevent fraying

Impasto	texture produced by the thickness of paint
Improve	make or become better
Inspiration	a process of being mentally stimulated to do something
Landscape	a picture of the countryside or paper used sideways
Line	a single mark made by a tool
Manufacture	make using machinery
Maquette	small sculpture in prep for bigger work
Measure	use an instrument or device to find a size of something marked in standard units
Media	materials used to work with
Mono	single image made using ink on a non-absorbent surface
Monochrome	a single colour
Mood board	visual presentation of images set in a composition based on a set topic
Natural forms	objects that come from nature
Observation	looking at something then drawing it
Oil paint	paint made from ground pigment and oil
Organic	relating to or derived from living matter
Pattern	a repeat of a single motif
Perspective	a method of representing something 3D on a flat surface
Pigment	the natural colouring matter of animal, mineral or plant

Pin	to temporarily attach two or more pieces of fabric together with a pin
Portrait	a picture of a person
Presentation	mounting work to show it off well
Primary colours	Red, Yellow, Blue
Printing	a method of image reproduction using template or carved block
Proportion	ratio between parts of an image
Prototype	a first version of a product
Research	the work you do to help your art by collecting or finding out something
Scissors	bladed tool for cutting paper or material
Sculpture	3D work in clay, plaster, Textile etc.
Seam allowance	an extra 1.5cm added around the edge of the shape to allow for the stitching to be within
Secondary colours	Green, orange, purple
Sew	attach with needle and thread
Sew	use needle and thread to attach two or more pieces of fabric together
Shape	the outline of something
Sketch	rough drawing
Skill	learn to do something well
Source	a place or thing which starts off an idea
Specification	precise requirements for a product

Structure	basic drawn lines that mark out a shape
Sustainable	be able to be maintained at a certain rate or level.
Tape measure	flexible ruler with cm and inches
Taylors chalk	flat tablet of chalk for marking out fabric
Template	an exact paper layout the correct size for the product, to cut around.
Thumbnail	small quick sketches for idea generation
Unpicker	tool to undo machine stitches
