

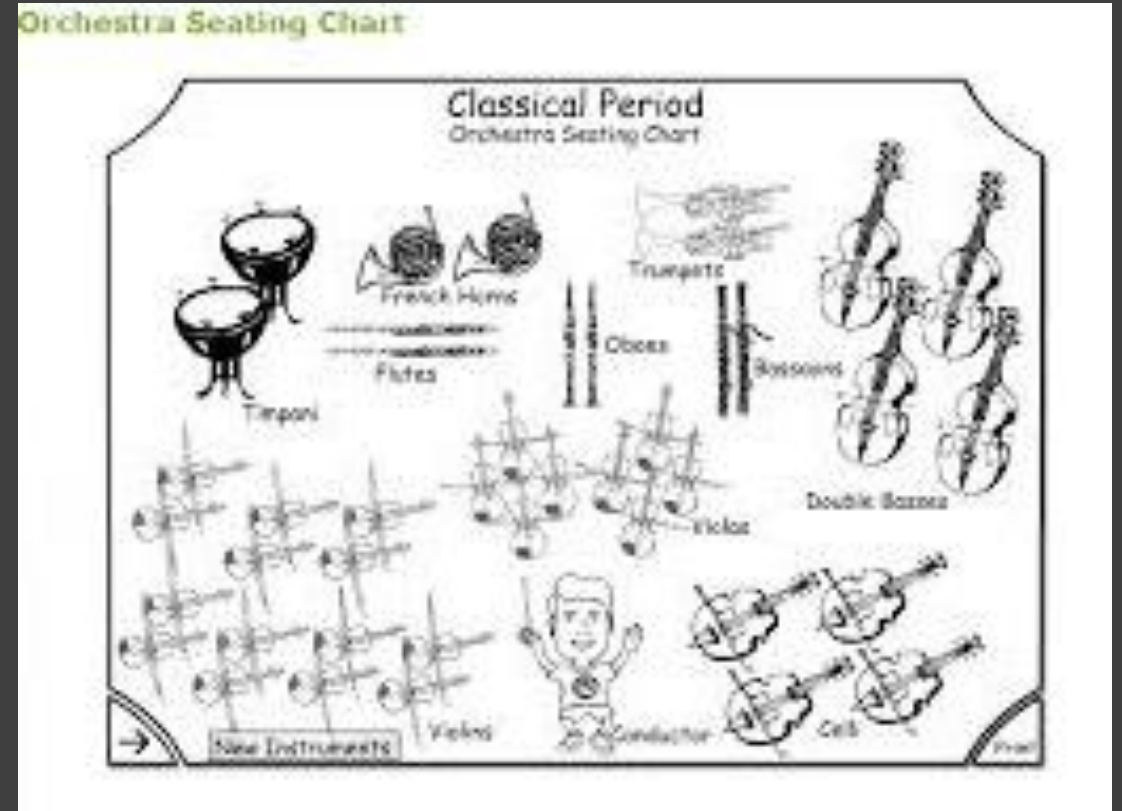

Often melodies comprise of folk songs but re worked using modern rhythms and textures as well as interesting harmonies.
