Summer School FAQ for Parents and Students

Model

Students will have four 60 minute sessions a day with a specialist teacher and a TA to support their learning. They will be taught in a mixed-ability group of no more than 20 students. Lessons start at 9.30am and finish at 3.30pm. **The arrival time for students is 9.15am.** Each day begins with Silent Reading and ends with Mental Maths. Students will cover a range of subjects and enrichment activities throughout the week.

Will students be required to wear school uniform?

Students are required to wear their full GCS PE Kit.

What equipment will my child need?

Students will need to bring in their pencil case and a water bottle in their school bag. Students will be issued with an exercise book and a Reading and Maths booklet. Please encourage your child to get into good habits by getting them to pack their school bag every night with their pencil case, water bottle, exercise book and Reading and Maths booklets.

Can students bring their phones in?

Students will be allowed to bring their phone in, but it must remain in their bag on 'silent' at all times.

Where do students arrive?

If arriving by car, please park in the lower car park. Parents and students are to use the lower gate and the internal school footpath to access the MUGA. Staff will meet your child on the MUGA and take them to class. Please do not arrive earlier than 9.15am.

At the end of the day, your child will be dismissed by their teacher on the MUGA. If you are collecting your child please wait for your child on the MUGA Plaza at 3.30pm and exit via the lower gate.

A member of the admin team will be in reception in the Sports Hall from 8am to 3.30pm. You may also contact the school by email krobinson@guildfordcounty.co.uk if needed.

Will lunch be provided?

Students will be able to buy lunch from the cafeteria. Free school meals will be available for those eligible students. There is a Breakfast Club which opens at 8.30am for a small number of students. Parentmail tabs will be set up for you to pay for lunch and breakfast club if required. This cost will be £3 a day for lunch and £4 a day if your child is also attending breakfast club. This will allow you to “buy” the correct number of days.
