Introduction to the Legal System in association with the UK Supreme Court

The Introduction to the Legal System programme gives students a chance to look at a case which was recently heard in the Supreme Court. Participants will review the decision made by the court, before coming to their own conclusions and writing a report outlining their thoughts and giving their own judgments. The project also gives the participants the opportunity to learn about the work of the Supreme Court - the highest court in England and Wales - and to engage with cutting edge legal policy, while at the same time learning about the role of our legal system more broadly.

The schedule for the project (via Zoom) is as follows:

- 22 April 6-8pm: An introductory lecture, explaining the basics of the English Legal System
- 29 April 6-8pm: A lecture on the relevant areas of law
- 6 May 6-8pm: Legal professionals panel talk providing insight into the Supreme Court case
- 13 May 6-8pm: A workshop to test the students' knowledge and report writing session
- 20 May 6-8pm: Further report writing session
- 14 June 10am: Deadline to submit report
- 18 June (time TBC): Speech preparation session ahead of final event
- 27 May 6-8pm: Final event. The best three students will present their thoughts about the case to a panel of legal professionals.
